Her four (soon to be five) books from Simon and Schuster include *Fly Girls: The Daring American Women Pilots Who Helped Win WWII*; *Fighting for the Forest: How FDR's Civilian Conservation Corps Helped Save America*; *Conspiracy: Nixon, Watergate, and Democracy's Defenders*; and *We Are Your Children Too: Black Students, White Supremacists, and the Battle for America's Schools in Prince Edward County, Virginia*. They have been honored on many "best of" lists including Bank Street, A Mighty Girl, and NCSS. Pearson is the recipient of a Grand Canyon Reader Award, a finalist for the NY-HS Children's History Book

Prize, and more. Patty lives in Fairfax City, Virginia, and can often be found talking about history as a volunteer with the National Park Service in Washington, D.C.
